## **Scorecard Example**

- 1. Compare the two golfers' handicaps. Circle the higher handicap Doug will get 5 handicap strokes in this match.
- 2. Circle the HANDICAP number of the 5 hardest holes. Doug will get 1 stroke handicap on each of these 5 holes.
- 3. Record the total strokes and putts for each hole in the proper row for each golfer.
- 4. To calculate <u>hole</u> points, compare the golfers' scores for each hole, and subtract 1 stroke for the higher handicap golfer on the designated holes. The lower net score gets 2 <u>hole</u> points. If the net scores are tied, both golfers get 1 <u>hole</u> point each.
- 5. To calculate <u>match</u> points, compare the golfers total scores, and subtract the difference between the golfers' handicaps from the higher handicap golfer's score. The lower net score gets 6 <u>match</u> points. If the net scores are tied, both golfers get 3 <u>match</u> points each. The MATCH points box should only contain 6, 3, or nothing.
- 6. Total points equals the sum of the <u>hole</u> points and the <u>match</u> points.
